NICHOLAS SCHOOL 2026-2027 ENROLLMENT CONTRACT

I _____ have enrolled my child _____
in the Nicholas School for the 2026-2027 school year.

I understand that the degree of my child's success and improvement is dependent upon the combined effort of school and home reinforcement. Families must be 100% committed to this program in order for it to be effective.

I understand that daily homework is assigned to most students. I understand that this homework is compatible with my child's developmental age and abilities, and is an important tool for developing responsibility and reinforcing skills. I understand that homework must be completed and returned to school on the day it is due, and that an appropriate consequence will be given for work that is not completed.

I understand that the Nicholas School program is highly structured with high expectations for appropriate behavior. Teaching appropriate behavior is part of the daily work of Nicholas School staff. Consequences for breaking school rules and being disruptive are consistently applied according to guidelines outlined in the handbook. It is necessary for these consequences to be reinforced at home in order for students to learn appropriate behavior.

The program at Nicholas School has the ability to be very effective for students, but it is not magic. It requires frequency, intensity and duration in order to produce desired results. A commitment of a minimum of one school year is required in order to determine the extent of progress that can occur.

It is expected that parents will attend Parent/Teacher Conferences, IEP/Service Plan meetings and Nicholas School functions such as Open Houses and Parent Nights.

In placing my student at Nicholas School, I agree to:

- Place my child at Nicholas School for a minimum of one school year, unless my family moves and it is no longer feasible to transport my child to the school each day.
- Support and reinforce disciplinary action aimed at developing age-appropriate behavior.
- Support the school program by following through with homework assignments.
- Attend Parent/Teacher Conferences, IEP/Service Plan meetings and Nicholas School functions such as Open Houses, and Parent Nights.
